VP-Publications Report – Xin Yao Presented by Garrison Greenwood

Greenwood provided a review of the activities of the Publications Committee highlighting the significant growth on the journals and future direction for all CIS publications.

Motion to change the name of the IEEE Transactions on Neural Networks to the “IEEE Transactions on Neural Networks and Learning Systems”.

The scope will be: “TNN considers technical articles that deal with the theory, design, and applications of neural networks and learning systems. In terms of subtopics, the scope of TNN includes: Mathematical Foundations and Learning Theory, Architectures and Algorithms, Neurodynamics and Attractor Networks, Hybrid and Knowledge-based Networks, Biological Aspects of Neurocomputing, Control and Estimation, Pattern Classification and Clustering, Image Processing and Recognition, Signal Processing and Communications, Applications, Implementations. TNN places special emphasis on the publication of high quality papers dealing with engineering applications of neural networks and learning systems.”

Transactions on Computational Intelligence and AI in Games Report – Simon Lucas (video report)

Reported that the editorial board is now complete with 40 members. Manuscript Central is working well though it has some minor challenges. Lucas reported on the promotional activities including a spotlight in CIM, status of submissions and future plans to increase visibility and submissions for future issues.

Transactions on Autonomous Mental Development Report – Zhengyou Zhang (video report)

Reported that the first issue has been published, the editorial board has been completed and approved. Zhang also reported on the number of submissions and plans to publicize the call for papers and planned special issues.

Transactions on Fuzzy Systems Report – By Jim Keller on behalf of Nik Pal

Reported on highlights of TFS, the impact factor is at its highest point and well ahead of its competitors. The TFS webpage has been updated with a three-stage procedure explaining the process of organizing special issues. The submission to first/final decision time has decreased 66% of decisions are made in 90 days of submission. The following highlights were discussed; special issues, manuscript central, application and short paper categories. The Excellence in Research for Australia (ERA) Initiative (introduced last year) ranked about 850 journals as A*, A, B and C, at any time, only 5% of journals will be kept in A* category. TFS is ranked A*.

Transactions on Evolutionary Computation Report – Garrison Greenwood

Reported on the statistics of the journal, the submission to final decision is average of 78 days; the publication queue is good and will meet the page budget. Greenwood also reported on the planned special issues and the status of the impact factor compared to other IEEE journals, TEC is currently ranked number one for its 5-year impact factor.

Transactions on Neural Networks Report – Marios Polycarpou

Reported on the status of T-NN highlighting key statistics of the journal. TNN is fully functional on Manuscript Central v4 with electronic final submission functionality implemented. Polycarpou discussed the submission statistics and the submission to first decision is now less than four months. Plans were discussed to transition the journal to Derong Liu, the new E-i-C to begin his term January 1, 2010. Polycarpou also discussed the possible name change to: *IEEE Transactions on Neural Networks and Learning Systems* to ensure long term sustainability.

Editor, CI Magazine – Gary Yen

Reported on the status of the Magazine highlighting the on-time production schedule, the submission statistics, and the diversity of topics covered within the magazine. Yen also reported on the contributions of the magazine to new technologies through the publication of special issues and the presence of “business” columns to communicate society information to the membership. Yen requested that all proactively recruit authors for tutorial articles, this will improve the JCR scores. The search for the next E-i-C and the potential for digital delivery were also discussed.
